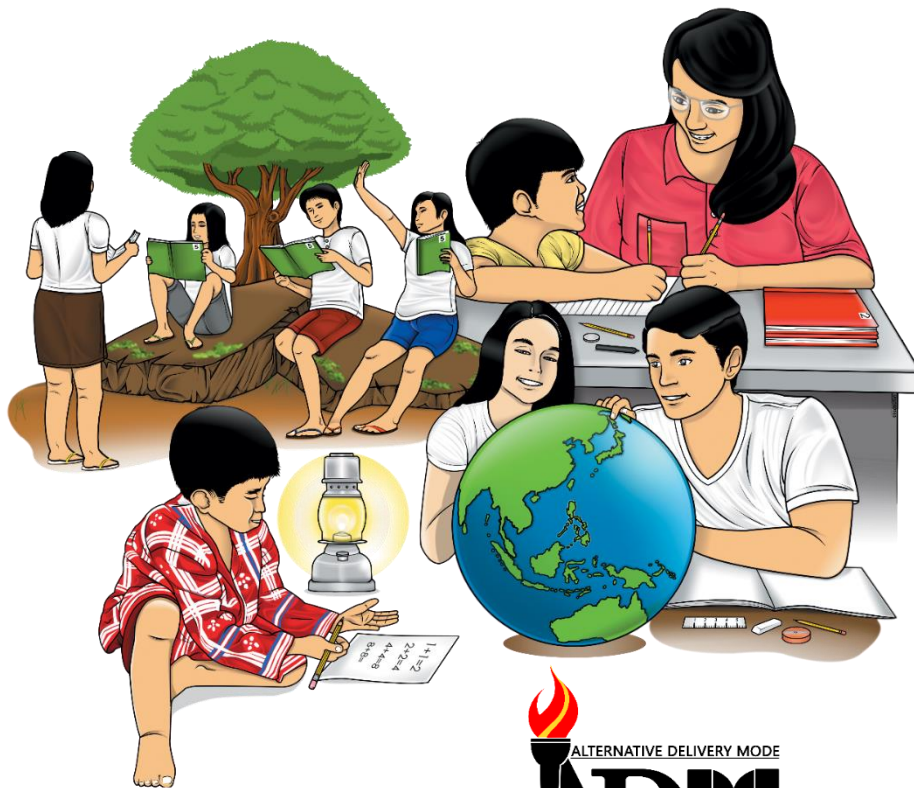

## **What Is It**

The Application of the finishing touches on a garment is the final steps such as in sewing a ladies skirt. It gives beauty and more quality results in a finished garment. Fasteners are also used as a finishing touches on garment like buttons snap, zipper also hand stitching. This are serves as a decoration in any kinds of garment.

- What are the supplies, tools and materials used as finishing touches?

**Fasteners** are used to help close garments securely. They include hook and eye, snap, special nylon tape, buttons, and zippers. There is a wide variety of fasteners for many different purposes.

1. **Hook and eye** -are available in a variety of sizes and types.
  - a. **Small hooks and eyes** are used most often at necklines and waistlines.
  - b. **Large covered hooks and eyes** are available for jackets and coats.
  - c. **Specialty heavy-duty hooks and bars** are designed for waistbands on pants and skirts.
2. **Snap** - are used to hold overlapping edge together where there is not much strain.
  - a. Small snaps are used at necklines or cuffs.
  - b. Heavy gripper snaps are used for children`s clothes and sport wear.
  - c. Large covered snaps are available for jackets and coats.

### **TWO SECTIONS OF SNAPS**

1. Ball- is sewn to the overlap of garment.
2. Socket - is sewn to the underlap of garment.

3. **Buttons and buttonholes** -used on all types of overlapping edges of garment such as collars, cuffs, center fronts and backs, pockets and waistbands. They are very strong fastener and are Able to withstand much pulling and strain.

### **TWO TYPE OF BUTTONS**

1. Sew-through buttons or flat
2. Shank Button

### **TWO TYPES OF BUTTONHOLES**

1. **Bound Buttonholes** - are finished with strip of fabric. They are made in a garment before the facing is attached.
2. **Worked Buttonhole** - are finished with thread and can be stitched by
  - a. Machine or by hand.
  - b. Machine - worked buttonholes
  - c. Hand-worked buttonholes

3. **Zippers**- are made of metallic and plastic coil with slider .They are available in different types, weights, and lengths. Zipper can be stitched in a variety of ways.

Types of Zipper

- a. Conventional zipper - is the most common types of zipper which has a stop at the bottom
- b. Specialty zipper
- c. Decorative zipper
- d. Heavy duty zipper
- e. Separating zipper

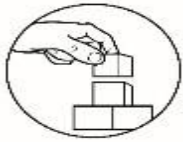
