

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

### **1,595 pupils participate in earthquake drill**

Malappo Elementary School (MES) conducted an unannounced Earthquake Drill in adherence to Memorandum no. 2023-04-1668 on the schedule for the conduct of Calendar Year (CY) 2023 Quarterly Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED) on March 22, 2024.

As a religious observance, this activity ensures awareness and preparedness for the impending threat of an earthquake even during a pandemic.

One of the responsibilities of teachers is to guarantee that learners are prepared to face such calamity for we never know when calamities would happen.

Furthermore, the School Disaster Risk Reduction Management (SDRRM) Team led by Juan Dela Cruz, SDRRM coordinator gathered the group to review the roles and responsibilities of each one to make sure that the activity will be done smoothly according to its plan.

To demonstrate some of the realities that can happen in an actual scenario, some learners were left in their rooms and were rescued.

The learners trapped in some of the buildings were assisted and those who acted to be injured during the so-called earthquake were given first aid so that children could witness how it is done.

Meanwhile, a post-evaluation of the activity was done at the school's gymnasium where pupils and all MES personnel were convened and processed the impact of the drill.

The psychosocial team conducted activities that relieved the stress that the learners experienced during the drill.

## **What is It**

The article presented is an example of News. What is news?

Campus Journalism defines news as a timely and factual narration of the past, present, and future events (Cecilia Cruz). This could be presented through oral, written, or visual mediums. It is oral if the medium used is the radio, written if it is through newspaper, magazine, and other reading material, and visual if it is through television, movie, and online/internet.

According to Soriano, et al (2012), the news is any oral, or written report of an event that happened, is happening, or will happen in the North, East, West, and South (NEWS) that is of interest to the reader, and which should be reported.

Malinao (2008) also attempted to define news by pointing out that news is basically about an event, idea, or reaction that is presented factually and simply in written form to give the reader an idea of what is currently happening around him or her, particularly on matters of interest to the community.

Another perspective about news is given by Estrada and Singh (1987), news is a timely factual report of events, ideas, or situations interesting or significant to people.

An additional viewpoint is also written by Puig and Flores (2005), news is any information that is significant to a particular set of readers.

News has different characteristics.

### **Characteristics of News**

1. **Accuracy** - It refers to the correctness of statements, names, figures, and other information.

3. **Factual** - It consists of actual persons and events with nothing invented.

News is information published in newspapers and broadcast on radio and television about recent events in the country or world or a particular area of activity.

News has different elements. Journalists are the best judges of what news is and what is not. They make this decision based on certain news values or elements.

LUCENA CITY — The biggest public high school in Quezon province located in this city will limit its days for in-person classes starting Monday, April 8, to protect teachers and students from the extreme heat.

“The Office of the School Principal announces the transition to limited face-to-face classes starting April 8, 2024 (Monday) until such time that the temperature becomes tolerable again,” the Quezon National High School posted this advisory on its Facebook page on Thursday, April 4.

The advisory announced that “Junior High School (JHS) students will attend school twice a week during the morning hours only, while students belonging to the Special Programs will adhere to their usual schedule but will only report to school twice a week as well.”

“Senior High School (SHS) students will attend classes only in the morning. Grade 11 students are scheduled to report on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, whereas Grade 12 students will report to school on Tuesdays and Thursdays,” the advisory stated.

The morning session and Special Programs will have their face-to-face classes on Mondays and Wednesdays, while the sessions will hold their classes on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

“Fridays will continue to be designated as catch-up Fridays. Teachers are required to send reading activity sheets to students for completion at home,” the announcement said.

It said that teachers handling the morning session are not required to report to school on Tuesdays and Thursdays, while the afternoon session teachers are not required to report on Mondays and Wednesdays “to give them time to prepare activity sheets to be used for the limited F2F or conduct online classes (if needed) at the comfort of their homes.”

## What is It

Knowing the elements of news is significant to you as a learner. Why? Understanding the elements of news will also help you understand and appreciate news stories more.

The following are the different elements of news:


### Elements of News

1. **Prominence** – deals with persons, places, things, and situations which are familiar to or of importance to the reader. For campus papers, prominent personalities include the *Supreme Elementary Learners' Government(SELG) president, the principal, the pupil who won in a national/international competition, and the like.*
2. **Proximity** – is the nearness of the event to the readers. *In the context of the news in the school for pupils in Tuguegarao what is happening to Tuguegarao East Central School will be of interest to them than what is happening to Palawan Central School.*

The new schedule, according to the advisory, complied with Regional Memorandum No. 233 s. 2024 or the Adoption of Modular Distance Learning and Preventive Measures during Extremely High Temperatures issued by lawyer Alberto Escobarte, director of the Department of Education in Region 4A on April 1.

Based on the state weather bureau's latest forecast, several areas across the country are expected to experience "danger category" heat indexes exceeding 42 degrees Celsius. (Delfin T. Mallari 2024)

3. **Immediacy** – refers to the timeliness of the event. *For instance, Pertussis is more appealing to the pupils rather than the news about COVID-19.*
4. **Oddity** – is an unusual or deviation from the normal course of events like a *pregnant man, a bearded woman, a twenty-eight-year-old pupil who has just graduated from elementary*, and others that are newsworthy.
5. **Human Interest** – deals with events that are appealing to the emotions. An example of this, is a *grandfather repairing shoes along the sidewalk to support his eight grandchildren, an orphan supporting himself at an early age, and others that touch the heart.*
6. **Conflict** – deals with any disagreement between a man and his fellowman, man and nature, or man and himself.
7. **Names** – involves newsworthy people like *those who pass the board examinations or win a contest.*
8. **Numbers and Statistics** – *results of sweepstakes, raffle draws, vital statistics of celebrities, cases of COVID-19 positive, deaths and recovered and even peso-dollar equivalent make good news.*
9. **Romance and Adventure** – “Love makes the world go round,” so a song says. Hence, *stories about love, including adventure, especially among celebrities and prominent people can arouse/ignite the reader’s interest.*
10. **Significance** – refers not only to the importance of the event but also to how it will affect the readers. In the campus setting, highly significant topics include *new rules imposed by the administration or the pupil government, upcoming big events/ projects, results Philippines Science Entrance Examination, and the like.*
11. **Development and progress** - *like putting up of schools, buildings, bridges, newly donated laboratory equipment from alumni abroad, and the like that could be news items.*
12. **Animals** – especially those unusual ones are also newsworthy like a *dog sent for an errand because its master is sick or cannot do the job.*
13. **Calamity** – newspaper pages devote stories and photos describing casualties caused by *earthquakes, typhoons, and other disasters.*


